



INTERCLASS WORKING GROUP

Creating an Inteclass Working Group (IWG) is a way to involve all school members in transforming your school into a Waterschool.

Interclass Group means that you should be able to involve:

- teachers of other classes;
- student representatives from multiple classes;
- representatives of parents of other classes;
- representatives of technical and administrative staff.

Not necessarily the IWG must be very numerous, at least initially.

A group of **3-5 people** may be sufficient, with whom to tackle the first steps we have just described, for example to carry out, distribute and evaluate the preliminary survey.

The Interclass Working Group can then become the project coordination group and then expand to other classes.

Another suggestion is to involve people with **different skills**, so as to have a sum of operational skills that make the group more flexible, involving teachers from different disciplines, for example.

In this way you can make the Waterschool project an opportunity for developing communication and collaboration within your school.
